I received lots of kind messages of support, as well as cards and gifts while I was off - thank you so much. The children have been lovely to me all week! I was in close contact with the supply teachers while I was off school and Mrs Payne and the rest of the school staff did a great job of keeping things going in Maple but I'm glad to report that we're back up and running as normal this week. We have been doing lots of challenging work about long multiplication in maths and have started writing letters as though we are evacuees in English.

The 4 children who attended K'Bots at Riverside on Thursday did an amazing job. The two pairs have been put through to the quarter-finals and semi-finals in March, which they are extremely excited about! Mrs Payne tells me that the children were outstanding representatives for Saxton school and the children were delighted to return as the winners at the end of the day!

Finally, two weeks ago, I challenged the children to a homework project to make a model of an Anderson Shelter and a 'Dig for Victory' garden. I gave the children two weeks instead of the usual one so that they could put lots of time and effort into this project. However, the results are way above and beyond anything I could ever have hoped for! They really are outstanding! I would like to say a huge well done to the children but also thank you to parents for all the support that you have given.
