HEADTEACHER NEWS

Dear Parents/Carers,

We have been having a few issues with emails over the last couple of weeks and so you have been getting some information quite late. I apologise for our poor communication and hope that we do better in the future!

We decided to defer Sport Relief activities until after Easter when we can make better use of the field. The field was used for the first time yesterday and there was great excitement; it was good to see the children running freely and enjoying the space. We just need some dry weather and sunshine! We also want to start using the woodland area again when it has recovered from the ravages of winter.

I know that some of you are concerned that there have been different supply teachers fairly regularly this term. Since September we have had to use supply teachers for the first time to cover sickness, training and PPE time for staff. Our priority is to provide stability for the children and staff while, at the same time, continuing with the school improvement priorities. We will let you know when we have some information regarding this.
