



100 club rules

Purpose

The purpose of the 100 club is to raise funds for both FOSS and PTA. The money will be paid into the Monk Fryston PTA bank account and then allocated to the relevant PTA/ FOSS to be used to meet funding requests from the schools, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

Rules

1. For a cost of £2 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between one and 100.
2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
3. The prizes will total 44% of the annual income.
4. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of 20%, 2nd prize of 10% and 3rd prize of 5% for 10 out of 12 months. The prizes for June and December will be higher with a 1st prize of 50%, 2nd prize of 25% and 3rd prize of 15% of the monthly income.
5. The 100 club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of Monk Fryston and Saxton Schools. Anyone aged 16 or over can join.
6. Monk Fryston and Saxton Schools will hold the data of the individuals participating for the duration of their participation. This information will be held securely in line with GDPR regulations. The schools' Privacy Notices for handling data can be found on their websites.
7. Numbers are limited to two per household.
8. Payments must be made by monthly or annual payment using ParentPay before 20th of each month in order to join that month's draw. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
9. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
10. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
11. The draw shall be made by the headteacher in the last Friday assembly of each month. Numbers drawn that have not been allocated or for which an appropriate payment has not been received, will be redrawn.
12. The winning cheque will be posted to the address on your membership application within one week of the draw.
13. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted in the school newsletter and on the school website.
14. The 100 club will be run jointly by FOSS and the PTA. The PTA Treasurer will track payments of numbers and will co-ordinate with the Treasurer of FOSS to manage the accounts, payments and income. In case of any dispute the two organisations will appoint a joint disputes committee with representation from each body to determine the outcome of the

dispute. The decision of this committee is final.

15. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month. In this case, personal details will no longer be retained.
16. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into PTA and FOSS funds after six months.
